

Allowing Pop-ups and Cookies

If pop ups are blocked, you will not be able to open many Blackboard content files. To solve this problem, you can allow pop ups from the Blackboard site (without enabling pop ups from other sites).

You must also enable cookies for Blackboard to function properly.

Allowing Pop ups in Internet Explorer 7

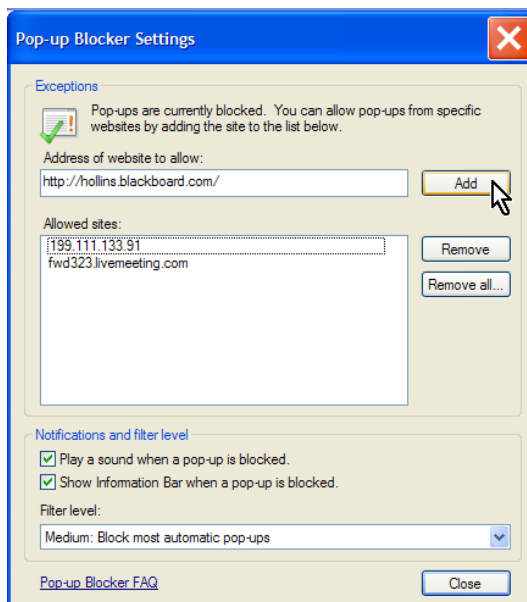
To allow pop-ups for the Blackboard features in Internet Explorer, do the following:

On the Internet Explorer Tools menu, point to Pop-up Blocker and click on Pop-up Blocker Settings.

If Pop-up Blocker Settings is grayed out, click on Turn on Pop-up Blocker and try this step again.

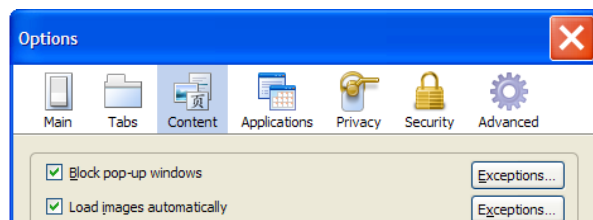
In the Address of Web Site to Allow box, type the following URL: <http://hollins.blackboard.com>

Click Add. Click Close



Allowing Pop ups from Firefox

On the Firefox Tools menu select Options

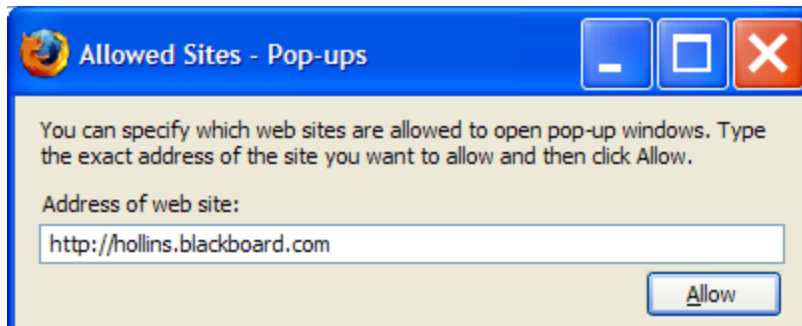


Select the Content tab

Check Block pop-up windows

Click Exceptions

Enter <http://hollins.blackboard.com> in the Address of web site: and click Allow.



Click Close; Click OK.

Close and restart your browser for the changes to take effect.

Blackboard and Cookies

For Blackboard to function properly, cookies must be enabled.

Enabling Cookies to be set in Internet Explorer.

Click on the Internet Explorer Tools menu select Internet Options

Privacy tab

Click Sites

Enter the address for Blackboard: <http://hollins.blackboard.com>

Click Allow.

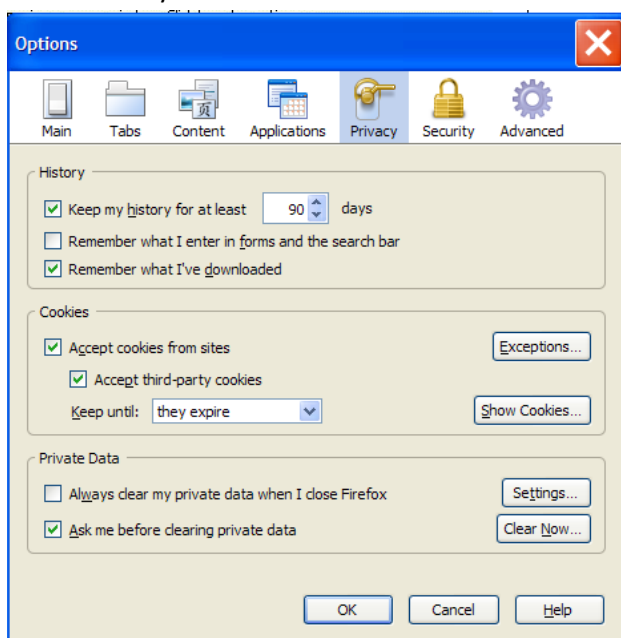
Click OK; Click OK again

Close and restart your browser for the changes to take effect.

Enabling Cookies to be set in Firefox

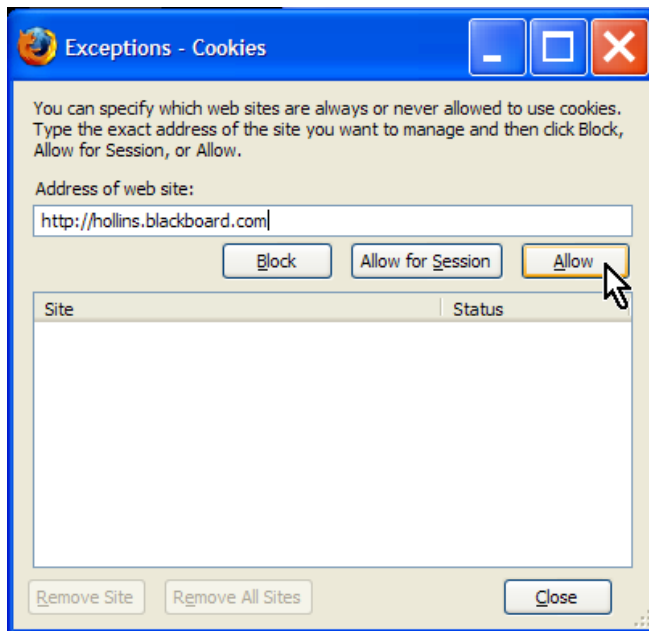
On the Firefox Tools menu select Options

Select Privacy



If Accept cookies from sites is not checked, click Exceptions

Enter <http://hollins.blackboard.com> in the Address of web site: and click Allow.



Click Close; Click OK.

Close and restart your browser for the changes to take effect.
